**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LEBANON, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON TO
AMEND THE CODIFIED TRAFFIC AND PARKING ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH
TO GOVERN PARKING ON MAPLE STREET**

WHEREAS, the governing body recently codified the Traffic and Parking Ordinances of the Borough of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body conducted a public hearing during which numerous citizens expressed their concerns regarding Maple Street, which serves as the main thoroughfare for ingress and egress to the Lebanon Borough School; and

WHEREAS, because of its unique configuration and volume of service, Maple Street, presents special concerns to insure the health, safety, and welfare of school children and the residents of the Borough in general.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Lebanon, with the approval of the Mayor, that the Traffic and Parking Ordinance Codification of the Borough of Lebanon is amended as follows:

- 1. Section 9–5 Violations and Penalties shall be renumbered as Section 9-10 - Violations and Penalties.**
- 2. Sections 9-6, 9-7, 9-8 and 9-9 shall all be Reserved for future, possible amendments.**
- 3. A new section 9-5 is hereby created as follows:**

9-5 Maple Street

9-5. 1 Restricted Parking – Maple Street During School Days

There shall be no parking on either side of Maple Street between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday (excluding school holidays), from September 1st through and including June 15th of the following year.

9-5.2. Limited No Parking

No person shall park a vehicle:

- a. On either side of Maple Street from Main Street to a point 260 feet in a southerly direction toward Brunswick Avenue, (that is, the end of the Municipal Building property), as shall be designated by appropriate signage.
- b. The entire east side of Maple Street.
- c. Along the west side of Maple Street, from the intersection of Brunswick Avenue in a northerly direction toward Main Street to a point 150 feet North as shall be designated by appropriate signage.

9-5.3 Limited One-Way Designation

- a. During the hours of (1) 8:00 AM until 9:30 AM, and (2) 2:30 PM until 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday (excluding school holidays), from September 1st through and including June 15th of the following year, Maple Street shall be restricted to one-way traffic from the intersection of Brunswick Avenue, in a Northerly direction from Brunswick Avenue to Main Street.
- b. At all other times, Maple Street shall be a two-way street.

9-5.4 Signage

Specific and appropriate Signage in Accordance with Manual on Uniform Traffic Control (MUTC) shall be installed and maintained to effectuate the traffic controls herein set forth.

4. Severability:

In event that any clause, section, paragraph, or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason; it shall be deemed severable, and the Borough Council hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the said invalidity, and the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

5. Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication according to law, and upon the expiration of the period for appeal, all existing traffic and parking Ordinance related to the regulations set forth herein, shall be rescinded and of no further force and effect.
